#### About the role

The purpose of the advertised role is to support a new Research Project titled Athlete and Coach Experience of Paralympic Gateways & Pathways in Ireland. The project, funded by Paralympics Ireland, aims to examine the lived experiences of athletes and coaches within Para sport in Ireland. The initiative aims to investigate what constitutes a positive developmental experience and what enhances the recruitment, retention, and overall sporting environment for Para athletes and coaches.

The successful candidate will be reporting to Dr Sean Healy (UL). <u>In collaboration with the project team</u>, the successful candidates will contribute to:

- Supporting development of data collection instruments (interview/focus group guides and survey)
- Supporting recruitment of athletes and coaches and data collection via interviews, focus groups, and an electronic survey.
- Carrying out administrative work to support the programme of research and any additional duties as may reasonably be required within the general scope and level of the post.

## **Candidate requirements**

- A degree (Level 8 NFQ) related to physical activity, sport, disability or other related areas.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Ability to interact with external stakeholders.
- Capacity to work independently and within a project team to achieve results.
- Highly motivated with excellent organisational skills.
- Experience with qualitative data collection and analysis
- Familiarly with Paralympics Ireland/Para sports.
